Replacing or repairing a dock leveler is something that needs to be done to ensure safety for your employees and equipment. You should replace or repair your old leveler if any of the following conditions are present:

- Rusty, broken, or missing framework
- Holes in the metal on the plate/lip
- Bowing of the plate/lip
- Missing, damaged, or broken parts
- Failure to operate properly

Dock Seals and Shelters

Dock seals or shelters play a crucial role in ensuring a solid seal between trailers and your building, as well as helping protect your building from damage. Dock seals/shelters that are worn out, damaged, or missing are costing you money in heating/cooling bills, as well as the peace of mind knowing your freight is properly protected from the elements, and your building standing strong. Dock Seals and shelters should be replaced if any of the following conditions are present:

- Missing, ripped, or tore vinyl
- Curtains separating from the shelter frame/dock seal pad
- Framing on shelters being broken/damaged
- Foam padding missing/wore out/too thin to ensure proper seal
